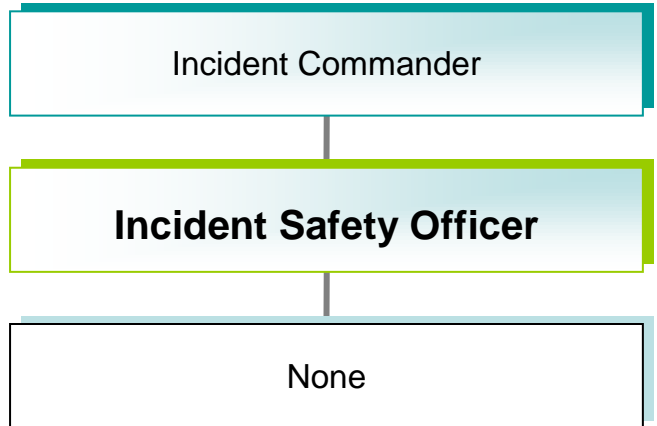


INCIDENT SAFETY OFFICER RESPONSIBILITIES

INCIDENT SAFETY OFFICER – The Incident Safety Officer advises the IC and/or the Operations Chief on issues regarding safety for emergency responders during an incident. Works with the Operations Section to ensure the safety of field personnel by modifying response activities or terminating response activities until undue safety hazards are addressed.



Complete	Incident Safety Officer Major Responsibilities
	Upon notification of Emergency Response implementation, pick up cache of supplies and checklist
	Report to the EOC and check in with the IC. Receive briefing regarding status of emergency and planned response.
	Make contact with the Operations Section Chief and advise regarding safety hazards as necessary.
	If necessary, notify the Operations Section Chief of response termination pending resolution of safety concerns. In the event of such a termination, work with all Command Staff to resolve remove safety hazards as soon as possible.
	Stay informed of the progress of the incident response and provide advice as requested by other staff or by the IC.
	Maintain a record of communications and decisions regarding safety during the incident to facilitate post-incident debrief.
	Debrief as directed.
	Submit completed activity checklist to the IC.
