The Skagit Valley College Art Department offers an Associate of Visual Arts Degree transferable directly to WSU, Pullman. Students interested in selecting an art major should follow the degree requirements listed below. Academic planning is advised because our degree is designed specifically for art majors. Students should meet with the department chair to outline a two-year plan that will prepare the student for a seamless transfer to WSU as an Art Major. Students will prepare a portfolio and slide or digital documentation of original work completed at SVC. The adviser and a committee of faculty will review portfolio progress at the end of the first and second years. Completion of the degree does not guarantee admission into the Art Major at WSU. A high G.P.A. and quality portfolio are essential to complete for admission into the major.
