

# PROGRAM MAP: GED® (GENERAL EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT)

The GED® is a certificate of high school equivalency for individuals who have not completed high school. The exam consists of four separate tests, one for each of the following areas: Social Studies, Science, Mathematical Reasoning, and Reasoning through Language Arts (RLA).

#### **BEFORE YOU START**

- Apply online to enroll for free.
- Take the <u>CASAS Reading & Math</u> <u>placement test</u> free of charge.
- Schedule an appointment with your advisor. Use the link for more info on GED exam prep.

#### IN YOUR FIRST QUARTER

- Set up an account at www.ged.com.
- · Connect with an advisor.
- Pay €25 tuition at the <u>Cashier's office</u> or request a waiver from your advisor.

## **EVERY QUARTER**

• Check in with your advisor.

#### IN YOUR SECOND QUARTER

- Explore the Areas of Study.
- Meet with an advisor to make an educational plan.
- Apply for <u>Financial Aid</u> and Foundation Scholarships.

## IN YOUR FINAL QUARTER

- Take the English & Math Placement.
- Confirm Financial Aid and Foundation Scholarships.

#### SAMPLE SCHEDULE

Based on student placement it will typically take one to three quarters to prepare to take all four <u>GED tests</u>. The sample schedule provided below will be tailored to meet the specific needs of each student.
