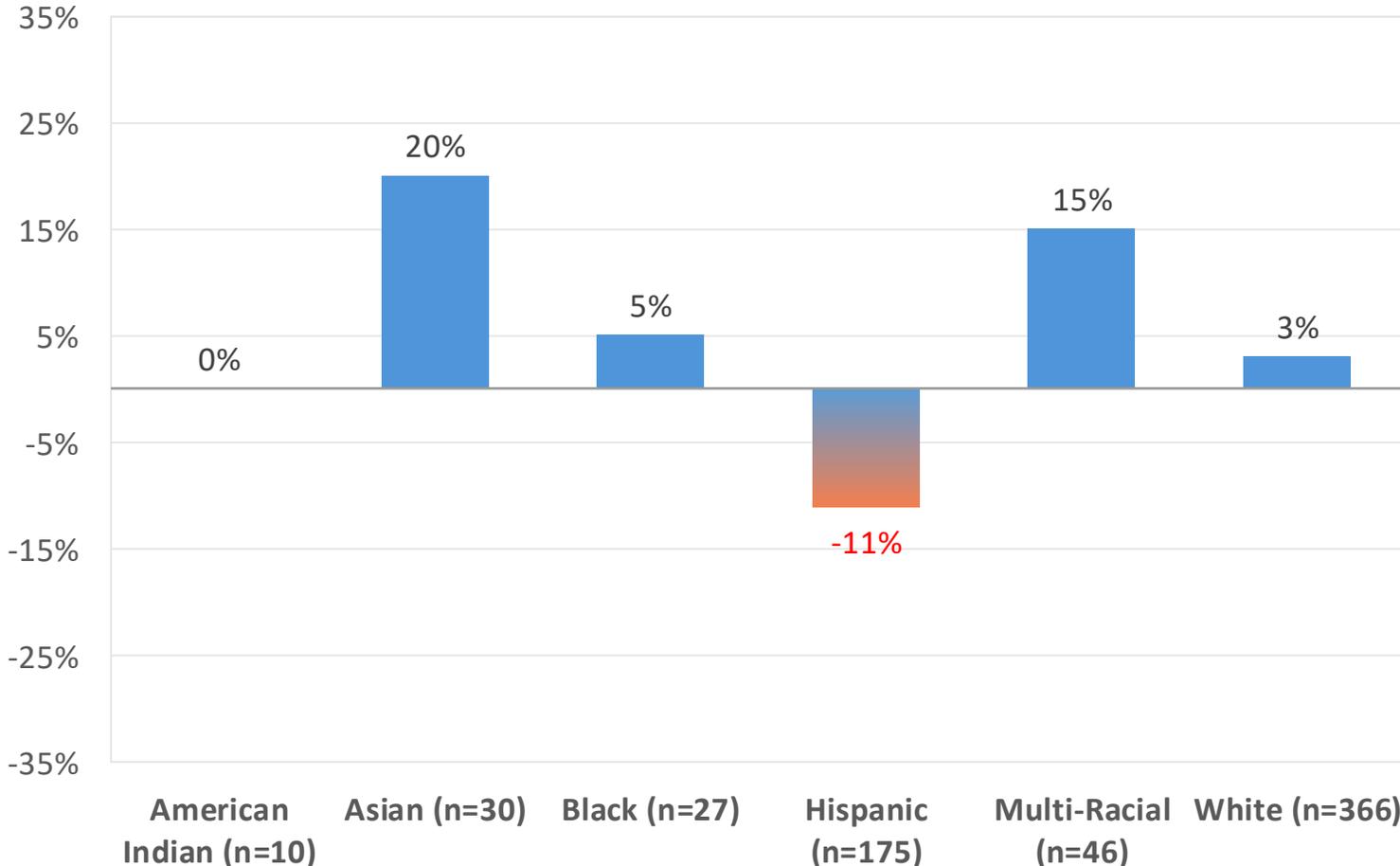

2025 ACHIEVEMENT GAP: RACE/ETHNICITY

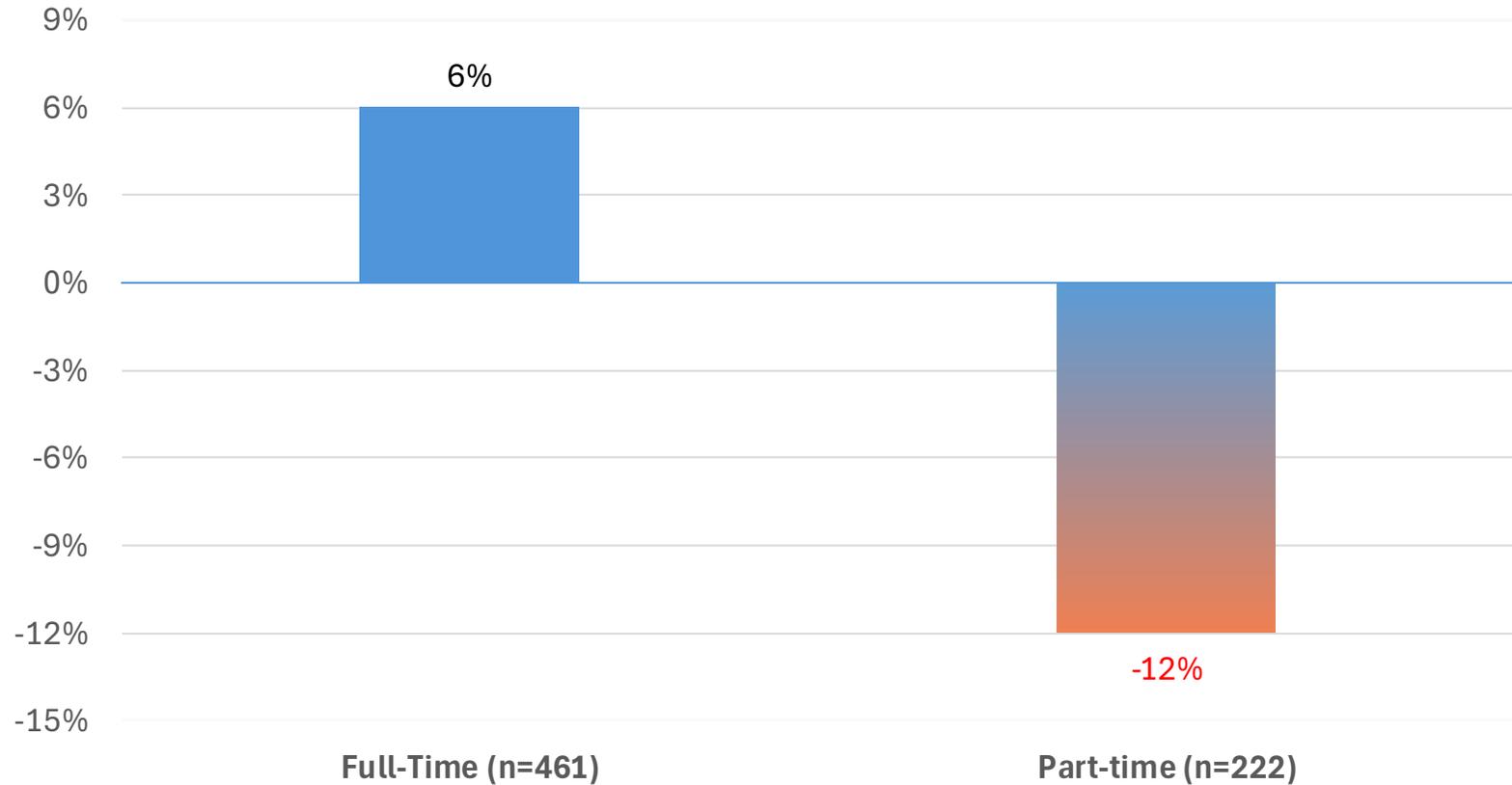

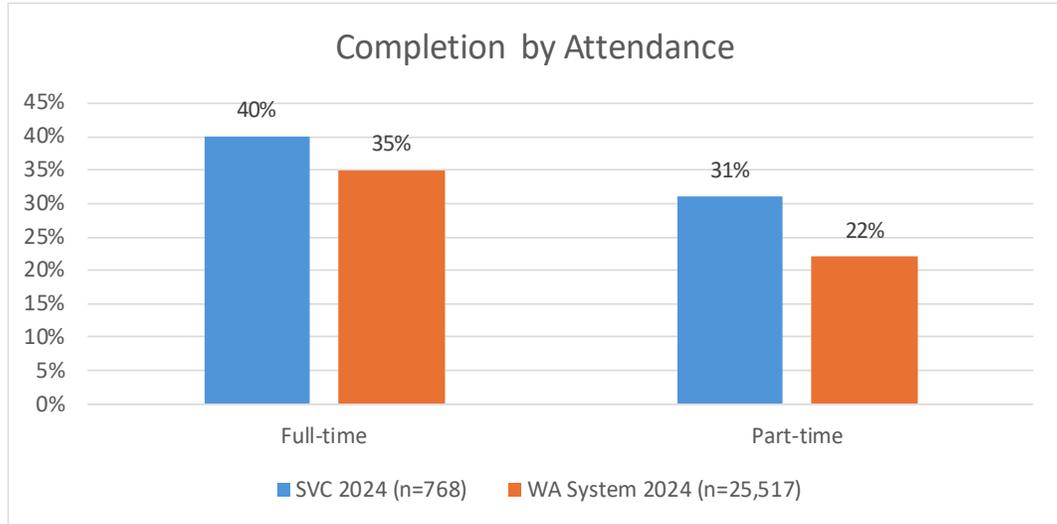
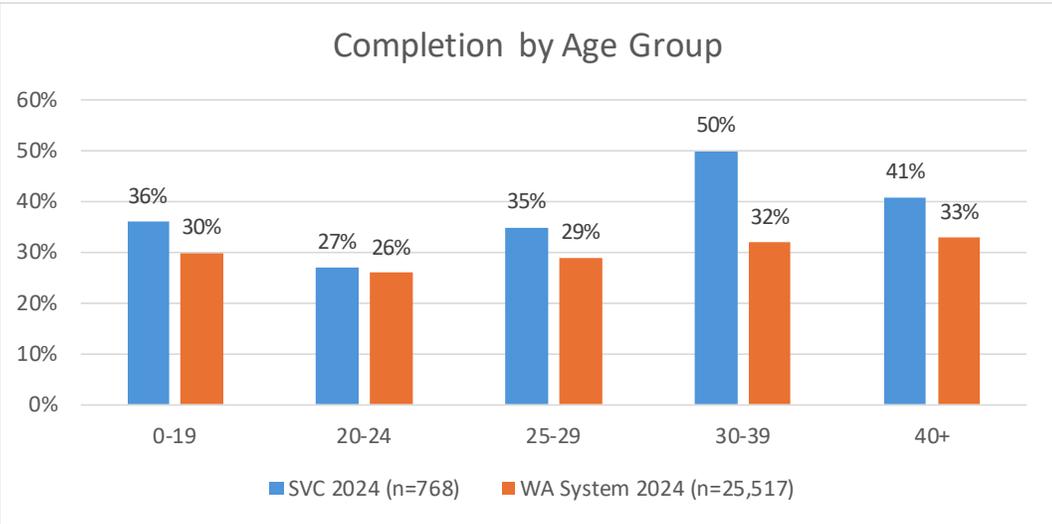
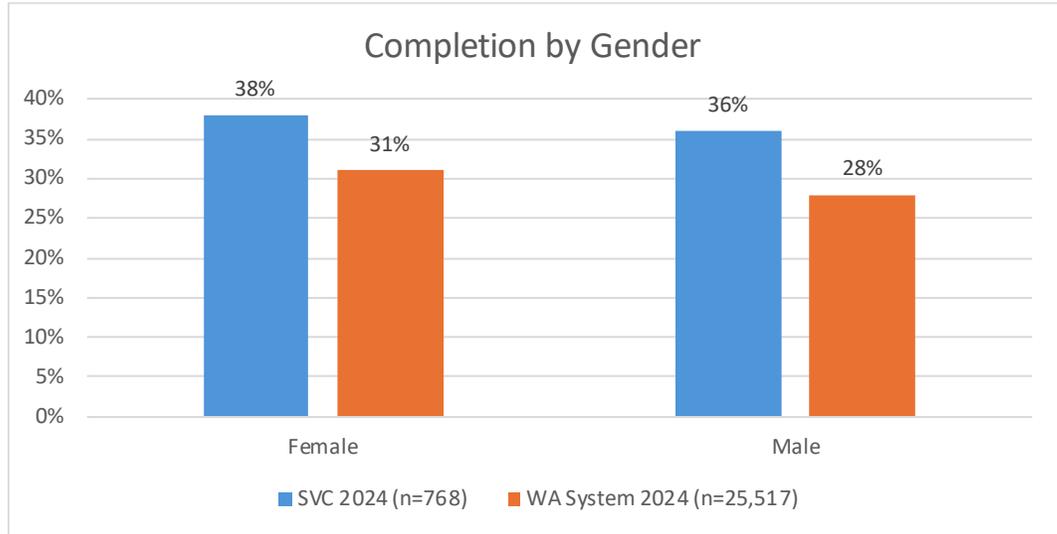
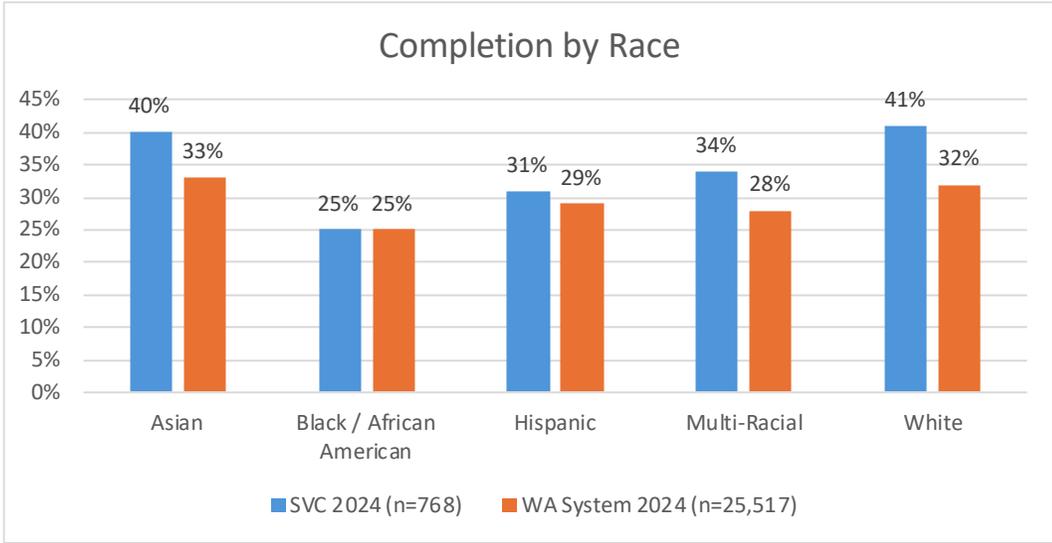
2025 ACHIEVEMENT GAP: ATTENDANCE

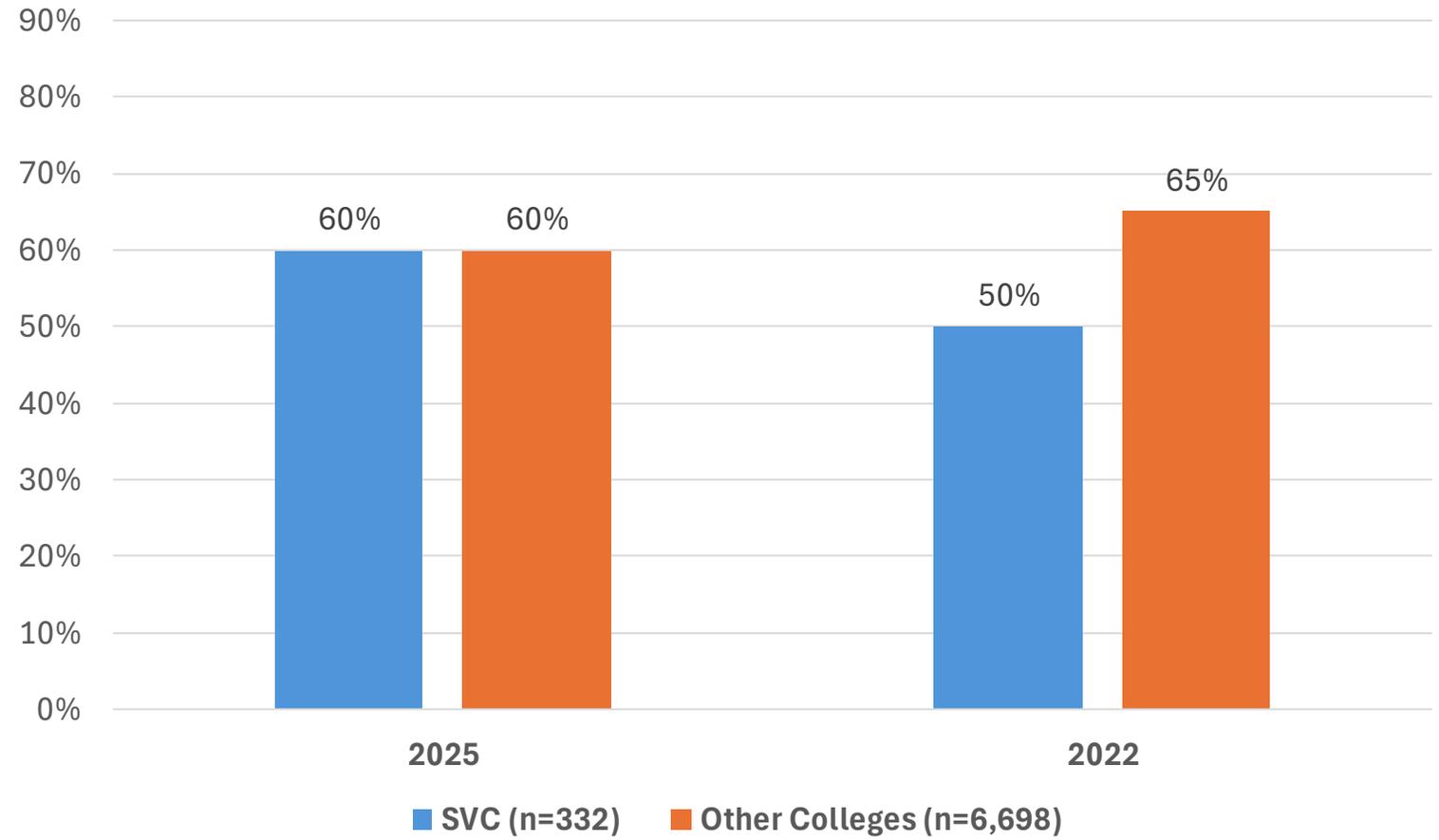

KEY TAKEAWAYS: OPPORTUNITY

Student Achievement Gaps

1. Only two of the six groups examined in 2025 show achievement gaps greater than -3% below the average
2. Students who identify as **Hispanic/Latino** currently complete -11% below the institution average
3. Students who attend **Part-time** complete -12% below the institution average
4. However, nearly all SVC student groups are completing at higher rates when compared to peers in the state system

Employee Sense of Belonging

1. Overall Sense of Belonging is 60% which is similar to peer institutions
2. Both faculty and staff show positive increases in specific measures of Sense of Belonging
3. 73% of SVC employees are generally or very satisfied with how they experience a Sense of Belonging at SVC
