- 2. Go to <a href="www.fafsa.gov">www.fafsa.gov</a> to complete and electronically sign your "18/19" application with your pin # (s). WASFA applicants go to <a href="www.ReadySetGrad.org">www.ReadySetGrad.org</a>
  - Hint: You will use your 2016 income on the form (if your 2016 income is drastically different than your 2017 income will be, please
    notify the Financial Aid Office regarding the change <u>after</u> your initial FAFSA goes through processing. A Special Circumstance
    petition may be desired)
- 3. Complete all paperwork mailed to you by the Financial Aid Office
  - The Financial Aid Office (FAO) will notify you of additional documentation required to complete your FAFSA after your FAFSA is received by the federal processor.
