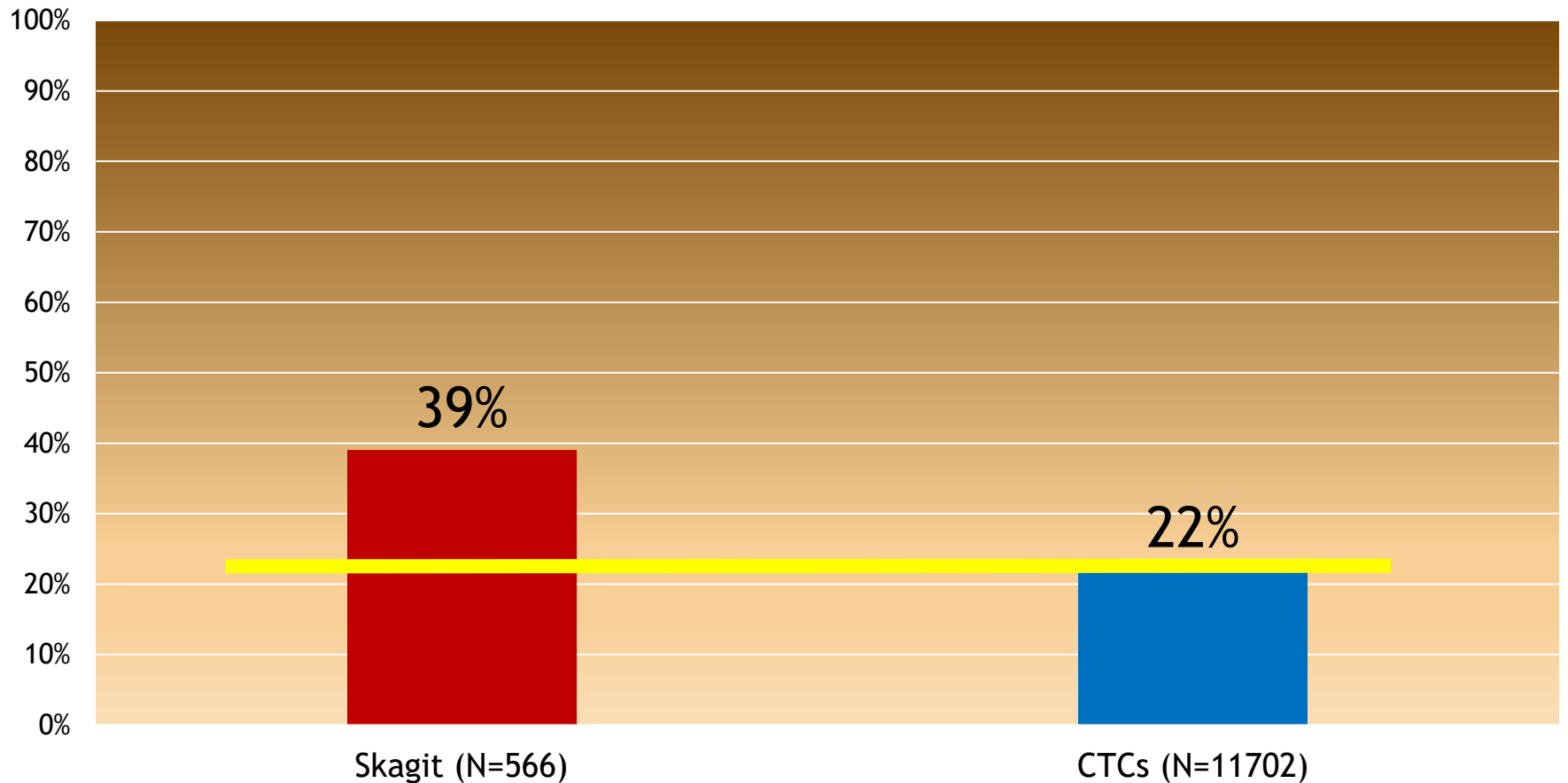

SVC CCB measures will meet or exceed the CTC system measures.

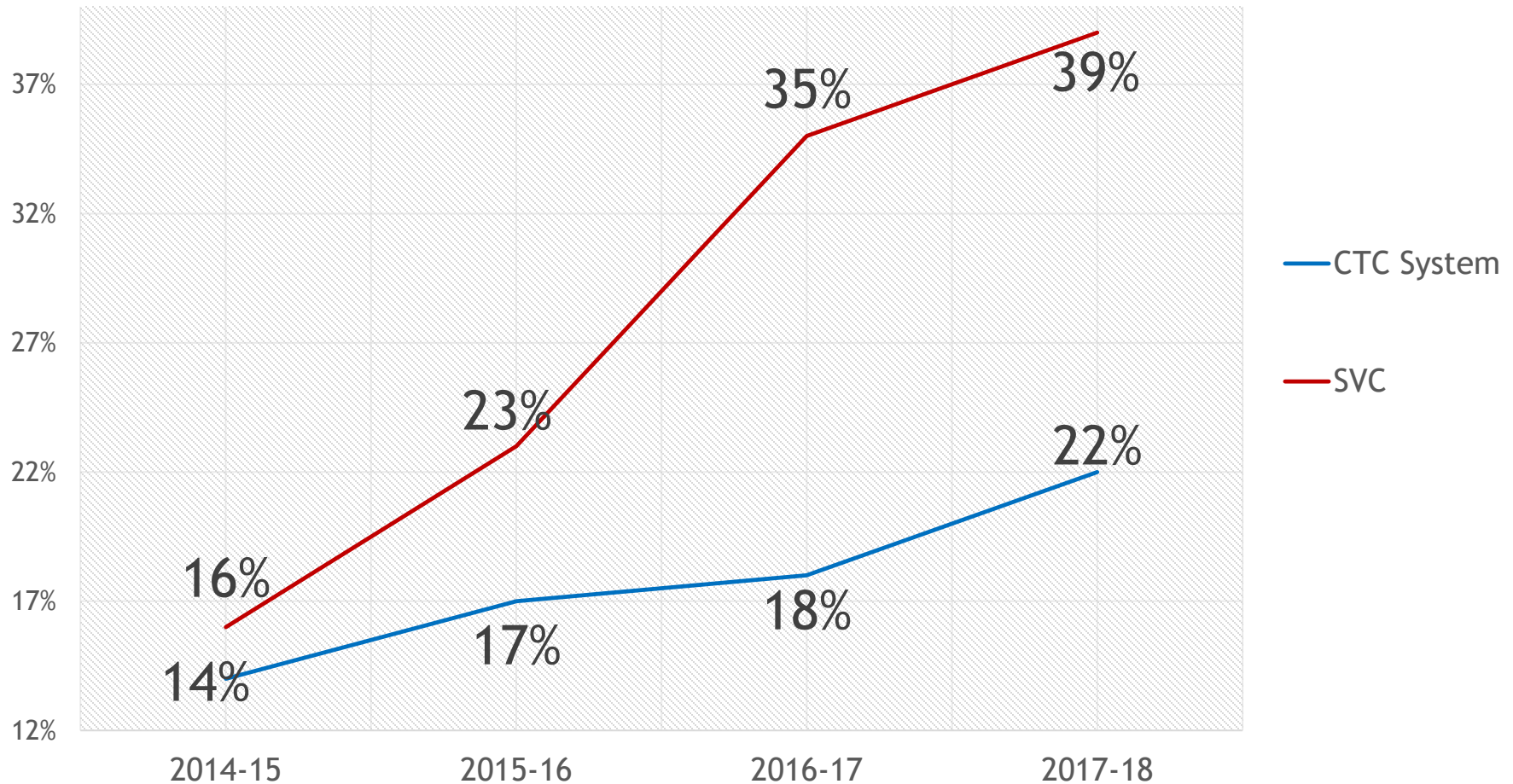
# SVC CCB Students Transition to College-Level Classes in 2017-18



SVC's CCB student transition rate to college-level classes is 17 percentage points higher than CCB students across the CTC system.



# SVC CCB Students Transition to College-Level Classes



SVC CCB students transitioned to college-level classes at a rate greater than the CTC system for the past 4 years.

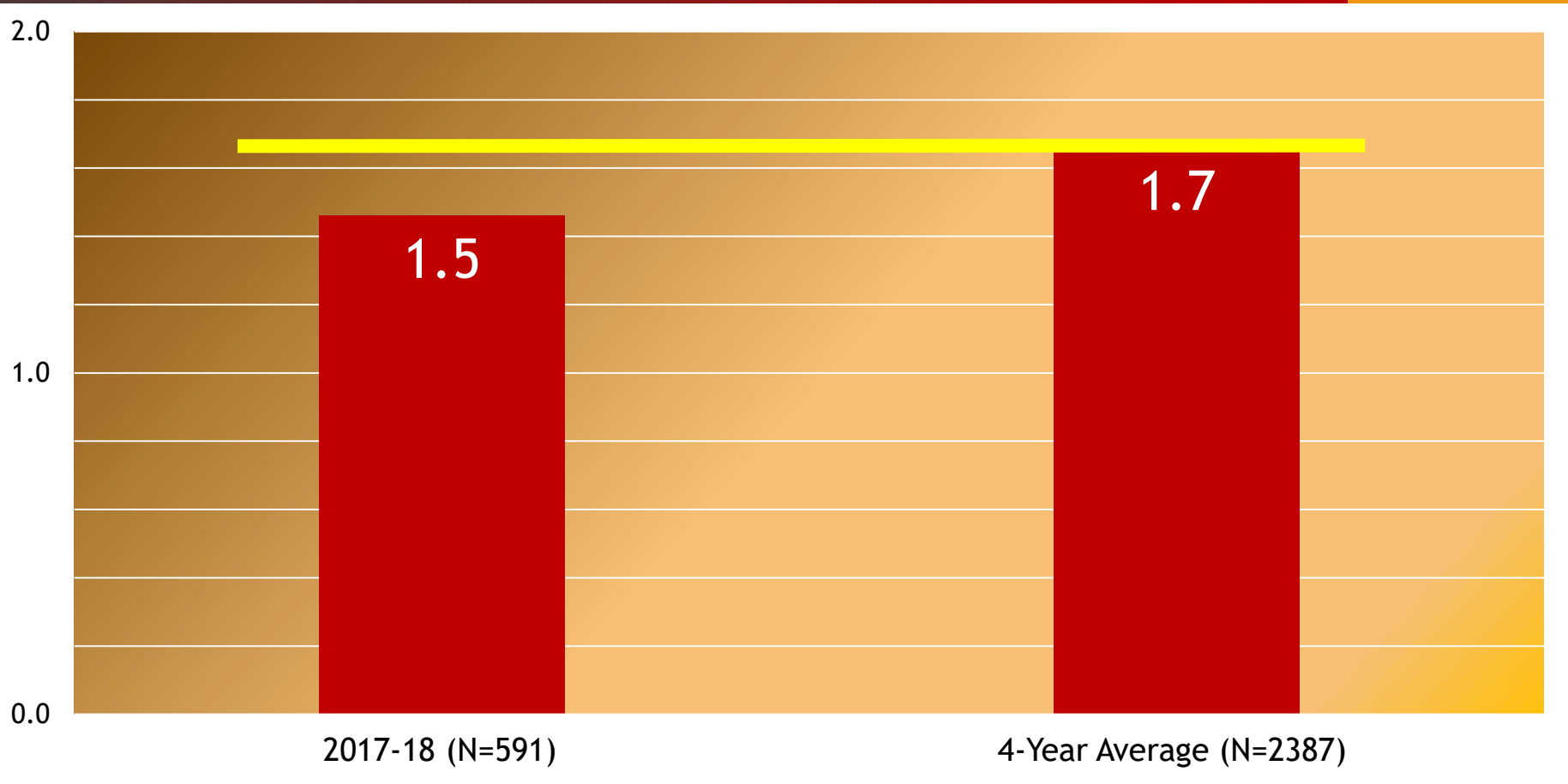
## ■ **Indicator**

SVC CCB and ELA students will meet or exceed the SVC four-year rolling average.

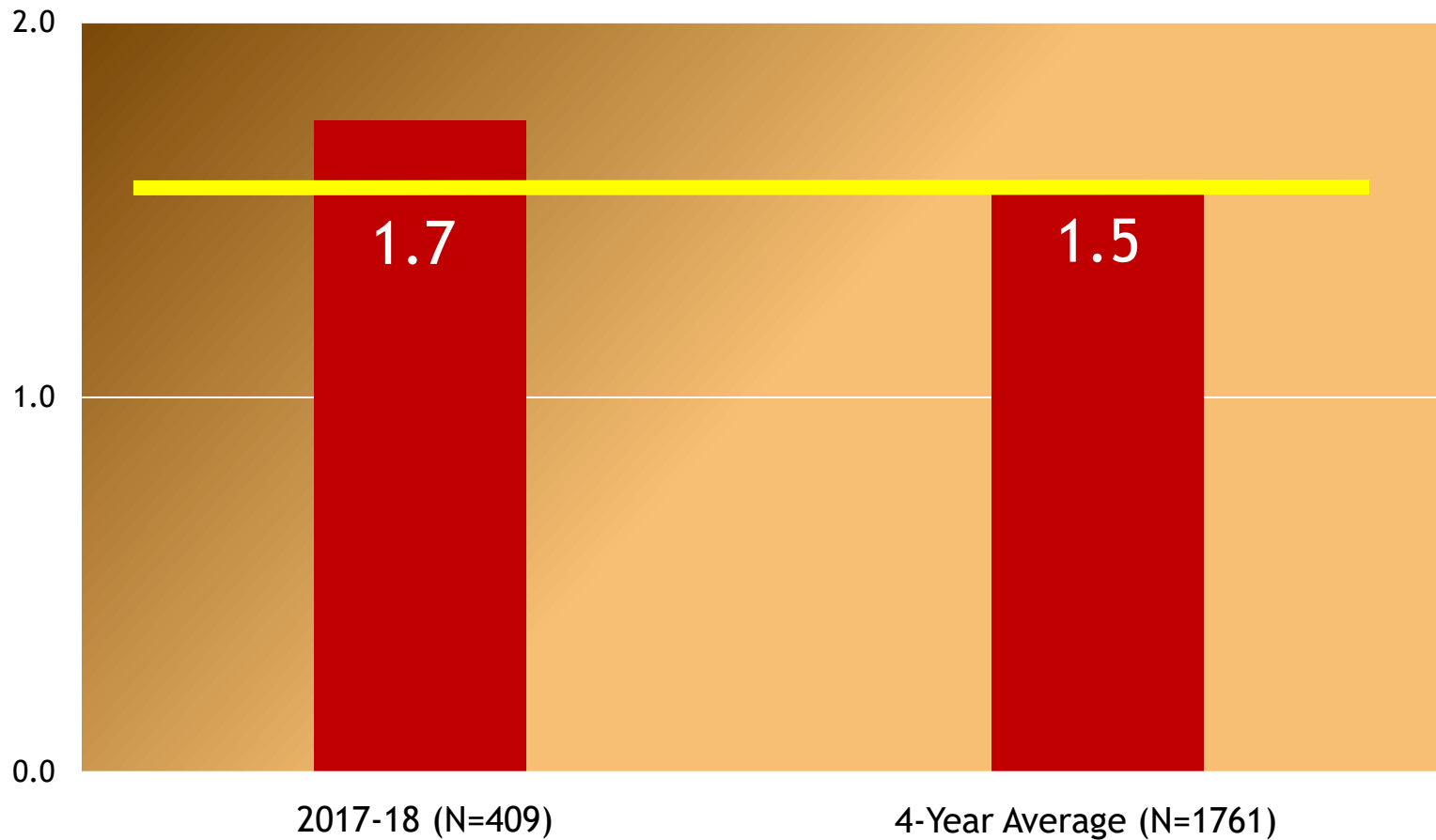
# SVC CCB Students Basic Skills Level Gains



In 2017-18, SVC CCB students earned fewer Basic Skills gains than the SVC CCB four-year average.



# SVC ELA Students Basic Skills Level Gains



In 2017-18, SVC ELA students earned more English language gains than the SVC ELA four-year average.



# In Summary

**SVC**

- SVC CCB students transitioned at significantly higher rates in 2017-18 and were 17 points higher than the System average.
- While CCB students made gains in terms of total SAI points in 2017-18, Basic Skills gains were below the four-year average.
- ELA students continue to show progress in terms of their Basic Skills gains.
- With our current and new initiatives, SVC will continue to support BEDA students transitioning to college level courses.
