

ADMISSIONS FOR UNDER-AGE STUDENT

This policy does not apply to any student in Dual Credit Programs including Running Start, Open Doors, College in the High School, etc.

Step 1 – Follow steps here: www.skagit.edu/apply

Step 2 – Take the Accuplacer test: Student needs to demonstrate placement scores that place the student into ENGL& 101, MATH& 097 or higher.

Students who are juniors or older:

Step 3 – Make an appointment to see a counselor by calling 360.416.7654 at the Mount Vernon Campus or 360.679.5319 at the Whidbey Island Campus. Bring to your appointment with a counselor the following items:

1. High school transcript or equivalent
2. Permission from the Principal or counselor of the school they are currently attending or the school district in which they reside
3. Copy of Accuplacer test results

Step 4 – The Counselor will assess the student's information and make the decision regarding admissions and enrollment.

OR

Students who are sophomores or younger:

Step 3 – Make an appointment to see the Associate Dean of Enrollment Services by calling 360.416.7663. Bring to your appointment the following items:

1. High school transcript or equivalent
2. Permission from the Principal or counselor of the school they are currently attending or the school district in which they reside
3. Letter from a school official or non-related adult addressing the issues of motivation, academic ability, and social maturity
4. Copy of Accuplacer test results

Step 4 – The Associate Dean will assess the student's information and make the decision regarding admissions.

Step 5 – If student is admitted, they can register for classes online or in person at Enrollment Services. Students are expected to pay by Tuition Due Date.
