1. You are required to provide proof of WA State Domicile.

- WA State Driver's License
- Vehicle Registration
- Voter Registration Card
- Income Tax Returns
- Documentation of Permanent full time employment
- Documentation of Home Purchase or Rental Agreements
- Documentation of A Bank Account in the state.

Washington State Domicile means the student veteran intends to remain in a "true, fixed and permanent place of habitation" in Washington State. The student veteran intends on remaining within Washington State and not to establish a new domicile. Please refer to [Revised Code of Washington \(RCW\), section 28B.15.012.](#)

- These qualifications include:
 - Honorably discharged from military service
 - Service in a war or conflict
 - These include:
 - World War I
 - World War II
 - Korean Conflict
 - Vietnam Era: For the period beginning on Feb 28 1961
 - And ending on May 7 1975.
 - Persian Gulf War: For the period beginning Aug 2 1990
 - If you participated and were awarded the respective campaign badge or medal:
 - The crises in Lebanon
 - The invasion of Grenada
 - Panama Operation Just Cause
 - Somalia
 - Operation Restore Hope
 - Haiti
 - Operation Uphold Democracy
 - Bosnia
 - Operation Joint Endeavor
 - Southern or Central Asia
 - Operation Enduring Freedom
 - Persian Gulf
 - Operation Iraqi Freedom
