


- CCSSE Pluralism Index score will be equal to or exceed the index score for similar-sized colleges.

### SVC CCSSE Pluralism Index




SVC students engaged in a culture of mutual respect and acceptance that embraces diversity and promotes a civil society more than students attending similar-sized colleges.

### SVC CCSSE Pluralism Index




The Pluralism Index is derived from seven measures, including ways students engage with fellow students and others in the community who differ from them.

### SVC CCSSE Pluralism Index




Other elements of the Pluralism Index include students developing a personal code of values and ethics, working well with others, and contributing to the welfare of the community.

### **SVC Vision and Services Survey**



SVC employees gave the College a 91% positive score for being guided by a set of shared principles – 16 percentage points higher than the threshold.

### **SVC Vision and Services Survey**



SVC employees gave the College an 90% positive score for being committed to equity -- 15 percentage points higher than the threshold.

The College will collaborate with its communities through the exchange of knowledge and resources.


### Indicator

### Threshold

Gelmon/Carnegie scores will average 75% of the maximum score.


### Gelmon/Carnegie Community Engagement Assessment



The College promotes community engagement through its Strategic Plan.

SVC employees rated the College 3 out of 4 for promoting community engagement through its Strategic Plan -- meeting the 75% threshold.


### Gelmon/Carnegie Community Engagement Assessment



Faculty and staff support and are involved in community engagement.

SVC employees rated the College 3 out of 4 for the level of involvement of faculty and staff in community engagement activities -- meeting the 75% threshold.

SVC employees rated the College 3 out of 4 for level of involvement of students in community engagement activities -- meeting the 75% threshold.

- 91% of employees report their work is guided by a set of shared principles.

- 90% of employees perceive that SVC is achieving its vision of being committed to equity.
