

5/4/22 - Class registration opens

- A **Summer Enrollment Revision** form is required to receive Financial Aid during the summer quarter, regardless of how many credits you register for. Turn your form in **after** you register for summer classes.

6/22/22 - Summer quarter tuition and fees due

- If you have the financial aid hold on your account as described above, the summer quarter tuition/fees due date **does not apply to you**.
- We suggest waiting to pay any remaining balance due until your financial aid has been applied.
- Don't have a FA hold on your account? You are responsible for paying the outstanding balance by the tuition due date.

6/29/22 at 12pm - Petition for reinstatement priority deadline

- If you fail to meet **Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)** during spring quarter, you will be notified after grades are finalized and reviewed.
- Petitions submitted by noon, 6/29 will receive priority review for summer quarter.

7/6/22 - First day of spring quarter and financial aid refunds

- For students who are eligible refunds will be released to BankMobile in the afternoon on Wednesday, July 6th.
- You must submit a Summer Enrollment Revision form to receive funding or there could be delays in your refund.

6/4/22 - Holds placed on student accounts with **possible** financial aid

- Do not become concerned if you see this on your account! This hold is in place to prevent you from being dropped from your classes until your financial aid is processed and/or paid closer to the start of the summer quarter.
- Review your To Dos and Financial Aid in ctcLink to make sure you do not have any outstanding requirements or documents.

6/29/22 - Vaccine attestation or exemption documentation deadline

- Students who plan to register for in-person classes for summer quarter must attest or apply for an exemption. More at www.skagit.edu/covid-19.
- If you are enrolled in on-ground classes and fail to complete the required documentation you may be moved into online sections or dropped from the class. **This could cause delays or reductions to your financial aid.**

7/5/22 - First round of financial aid disbursements towards **tuition and fees only**

- Monday, July 4th the Financial Aid office will be closed for Independence Day Holiday.
- Mid-morning to early afternoon on Tuesday, July 5th the first disbursement of financial aid will be applied to eligible student accounts. This process applies to tuition and fee charges only.
- **You will not receive a BankMobile refund until at least the first day of the quarter, July 6.**
