Math Requirements - Students who place below 100 level in Math may opt for one of two options:

1. Enroll in a math course 1st period at AHS, schedule permitting. **OR**
2. Pay to enroll in a non-college (below 100) level course at SVC.

AHS Graduation Requirements

- Running Start seniors are required to complete all of the AHS requirements for graduation.
- This includes meeting the State Graduation Pathway requirements for English and Math.
- Full time Running Start students must also complete the AHS Advisory requirements through one of the SVC courses listed in that section above, and Community Services hours.
- Part time Running Start students, enrolled in AHS Advisory, must complete all High School & Beyond Plan requirements (Resume, Senior Experience Project, Community Services Hours, Credit Audit)
- To participate in the AHS Commencement Ceremony, *seniors must be enrolled in at least 12 credits winter and spring quarters.*
